Administration Report:

- Lloyd George had our first Covid 19 case reported by Interior Health on Saturday, February 6. One class away for 2 weeks. All parents from that class were contacted Saturday night, as well as all Lloyd George staff. A voicemail was sent to the rest of the school parents Sunday morning.

- Kindergarten registration complete. 67 kids registered, and 6 on the wait list.
