Administration Report

New Items

- Street mural – LG asked to create a street mural. Administration at city level aware but details need to be worked out
- Pest management in Kindergarten classes.
 - Concern brought forth about pest control (ants) in the K classes regarding chemical use
 - SD73 decides when to deal with the problem and did bring a company in to spray perimeters in the morning that were dry (and deemed safe) before students arrived at school

 - Concerns brought forth about the amount of sugar in the food that is sold at movie nights and talk was made of changing what is offered
